

**MINUTES from the  
Town of Harris  
Annual Board of Canvass Meeting  
Tuesday, March 11, 2014  
Time: Immediately followed the Annual Harris Town Meeting**

The Harris Town Board of Canvass was called to order by Vice Chairman Gary Rosato at approximately 9:05 pm on Tuesday, March 11, 2014, to canvass the votes of the annual town election held earlier this day. The following members of the Canvass Board were present: Gary Rosato, Larry Key, and Dennis Kortekaas. Absent: none.

The township election results were received from the election judges, and the votes received were read by Vice Chairman Rosato as follows:

The Vice Chair Rosato then introduced Resolution #2014-003 (see attached), which certified the results as stated above.

***A motion was made by Supervisor Rosato, seconded by Supervisor Key to adopt Resolution #2014-003 A Resolution Certifying March 11, 2014 Harris Township Election Results, and declaring Dennis Kortekaas the winner for the position of Supervisor B (for a three year term), and declaring Michele Smith the winner for the position of Clerk (for a two year term), a declaring that the town board adopt a five person board of supervisors. Upon roll call, motion carried unanimously.***
