3. Business from the floor

- Jason- Media Com- talked about the internet from the town hall. Everything is running the way it is supposed to do. Only time the service dropped was when the camera was on. We need to have more up speed to do the live meetings. Recommendation is getting the higher upload speed. Working on getting started this year on the new internet line done. Media Com went over the internet speeds and the needs of the customers. We need at the town hall 20/2, and we will start with that and go from there to make sure that the live streaming works for the residents.
- Dan Butterfield- Variance on Sunny Beach road it has been table up to 6 months from the County. Looking at the findings of facts sheet we feel that maybe there should be changes to the form and Mr. Shaw to look and go to the township association for the Findings of facts examples. Over all cover for all the townships. Look at changing our findings of facts for this property. It will go back to the board of adjustment and not to the township.

Motion to get the bids and get the trees taken down made by Supervisor Kortekaas seconded by Supervisor Clayton passed by all.
- Woodland Patches one was fixed the other they missed and the board called them and will be coming back out to fix the hole.
- Wood tick update moving forward and is optimistic that everything is going good, will be at the P & D meeting with an update.
- Metzenhuber road washout the maintenance crew filled in the wash out are, we really need to do something about that. We need to figure out a way to slow down the water. Have S.E. H look at it for ideas. Motion to have S.E. H. look at the road made by Supervisor Haubrich seconded by Supervisor Schack passed by all.
